

Introduction

The MoD requires that all prospective Authorised Persons responsible for Working at Height (Restricted High Places) have training in Joint Services Publication 375 Volume 3 Chapter 7. Turner Facilities Management Limited is a MoD approved provider for this training.

Aim

The aim of the course is to ensure that those involved in MoD Safe Systems of Work for Working at Height (Restricted High Places) have sufficient knowledge to allow them to, where appropriate, proceed along the path to appointment.

Objectives

The objective of the course is to produce individuals who are capable of carrying out the duties of Authorised Person (Working at Height) without further trainingⁱ. We aim to train delegates to:

- Have sufficient knowledge of and able to recognise the hazards and safety requirements for working at height.
- Have an understanding of safe systems of work and to be able to apply that knowledge to the implementation of MoD Safety Rules and Procedures as laid down in Chapter 7.
- Be familiar with the requisite documentation and its application

Content

The course will comprise the following:

- Chapter 7 in detail
- Types of Structure including elements of masts, towers and fixed access ladder systems
- Equipment (receiving & transmitting)
- Standard nomenclature
- Safety, risk assessment and safety method statements
- Interview & appointment
- Documentation exercises & end of course tests

Who Should Attend

The training given on this course provides the basic knowledge for the Authorised Person who will be required to carry out duties under the MoD Safety Rules and Procedures set out in Chapter 7. Delegates do not need to hold any climbing qualifications to attend the course.

Duration

3 days

Award

On successful completion of the course each delegate will be awarded a Certificate of Competence.
