

Introduction

MoD requires that all prospective Authorised Persons and Authorising Engineers responsible for Mechanical installations have training in Joint Services Publication 375 Volume 3 Chapter 4. Turner Facilities Management Limited is a MoD approved provider for this training.

Aim

The aim of the course is to ensure that those involved in MoD Safe Systems of Work for Mechanical Systems have sufficient knowledge to allow them to, where appropriate, proceed along the path to appointment, or re-appointment.

Objectives

The objective of the course is to produce individuals who are capable of carrying out the duties of Authorised Person and Authorising Engineer. We aim to train delegates to:

- Have sufficient knowledge of and able to recognise the hazards and safety requirements for working with Mechanical Systems.
- Have an understanding of safe systems of work and to apply that knowledge to the implementation of JSP 375 Volume 3 Chapter 4.
- Be familiar with the requisite documentation and its application.

Content

The course will comprise the following:

- Overview of applicable and related Statutory Regulations
- A review of system definitions and properties
- Pressure Systems Safety Regulations
- JSP 375 Volume 3 Chapter 4 – Intro, Scope, Roles, roles/responsibilities/duties and appointments of Appointed Personnel, Safety Documentation
- Site Surveys, System Categorisation and Demarcation Agreements
- Risk assessments, plant room and general hazards
- Isolation Methodology and HSG 253 'Safe Isolation of Plant and Equipment'
- Safety Documentation including documentation exercises
- Audit and Monitoring
- End of course tests

Who Should Attend

The training given on this course provides the basic knowledge for the Authorised Person and Authorising Engineer who will be required to carry out duties under JSP 375 Volume 3 Chapter 4.
