Challenge

To apply the Inspection Requirements of Practitioners Guide 01/09 "Inspections of Fuel Infrastructure and Flammable Goods Facilities", produce documents that are fully compliant, yet cut the costs to the MoD.

Solution

Under MoD JSP 375 Volume 3 Safe Systems of Work Chapter 5 requires the Authorising Engineer Petroleum to review the condition of the Petroleum Fuel Infrastructure and Flammable Goods Facilities during his audit. The Authorising Engineer Petroleum working in conjunction with the Authorised Person Petroleum have an intimate knowledge of the Infrastructure and Facilities in their appointed locations.

By adding extra time to the Authorising Engineer's site visit, he has sufficient resource to complete a thorough examination of the installations.
